## Import to Namibia

### Who qualifies for duty free?

- Returning Namibian nationals who have been out of Namibia for more than 6 months
- Persons with residence permit or work permit (not work visa)
- Persons with a Certificate of Domicile
- Seconded experts under bilateral agreement and diplomatic personnel

### General requirements

- Personal goods must be imported within 6 months after returning to Namibia or after receiving a residence / work permit or Certificate of Domicile
- Only used goods may be imported
- Packing lists in English
- Original passport with all visas, departure and entry stamps
- Advisable that personal goods do not arrive prior to the arrival of the importer in Namibia
- Special provisions may be applicable under Bilateral Technical Cooperation Agreements

### Restrictions\*

Items subject to special provisions:  
Alcohol, weapons, drugs, plant & animal products



## Vehicles

- Vehicle is imported as part of personal goods
- Vehicle must have been in the possession of the importer for at least 12 months
- Only one motor vehicle (car or motor cycle) can be imported per household
- Vehicle evaluation in English, Birthing certificate & import permit is required
- Right hand drive vehicles only
- Vehicle is not older than 5 years
- Vehicle is only exempted from import customs duties; import VAT has to be paid
- Special arrangements may apply under Bilateral Technical Cooperation Agreements

## Live Animals

- Original Health Certificate
- Inoculation booklet for pet
- Water / food dispenser & absorbent material for crate
- Pet should be micro-chipped



## Export from Namibia

### General requirements

- Copy of passport
- Packing list with value per item
- Country specific documents\*

### Restrictions\*

Items subject to special provisions:  
Plant & animal products, foodstuffs, weapons / ammunition, alcohol, any dangerous goods

## Vehicles

- Carnet de Passage or Namibia Police Clearance
- Invoice / value declaration of vehicle

## Live Animals

- See information 'Import of Live Animals'
- Export to the EU\*: blood test for antibodies against rabies (30 days after vaccination & 3 months prior to entry)

\*Additional documentation may be required depending on country of destination / origin.
